We will also use ropes with red wine and UV-light and try to attract nocturnal moths and butterflies. Bring a flashlight or head lamp and enjoy the magical Danish summer nights and the strange summer song from the European Nightjar.

Cranes and cranberries on Randbøl Heath

Plants, berries and schnapps



Join our nature guide Sam in foraging edible plants from the heath. You will learn which plants that taste well, how to use them and what to be aware of when gathering wild plants.

Together we will find herbs and berries, so bring your own basket to carry them in. If you are interested in collecting plants to produce schnapps, remember to bring your own patent glass or other glass jars to produce the schnapps in. The trip will take place on nature paths but also in tall and sometimes semi wet vegetation, so remember fitting clothing and shoes. The trip is not suitable for people with walking disabilities.

We will start the evening on Randbøl Heath by looking for lingonberries, blueberries and cranberries to get a taste of the some of the berries to be found on the heath. We will also look at the flowering heather and some of the other characteristic plants on the heath; crowberries, cross-leaved heath, purple moor-grass, wavy hair-grass, tormentil etc. We will end the trip by walking up to the top of Staldbakkerne, where a beautiful view of Randbøl Heath unfolds. This is where we hopefully will be able to experience the cranes when they fly by towards their evening rest in the southern part of the heath. If we are lucky, we'll be able to hear the cranes evening song while the sun sets.

The hike is not only on road and paths, but also through tall and potentially wet vegetation, so remember clothing according to this. The trip is not suited for decreased walking ability.

Mushroom hunting



Join a skilled mushroom hunter, nature guide Peer Høgsberg, in Gyttegård plantation on the hunt for edible mushrooms. Peer will teach you about the mushrooms you find, and how to tell them apart.

On the tour through Gyttegård plantation we will pass by the unique inland dune area Grene Sande. All participants are offered the chance to have their baskets examined after the tour. We will walk approximately 5 km in varied terrain. Bring your own mushroom basket, a small kitchen knife and if possible, a small brush. You are also encouraged to bring portable coffee and of cause suitable outdoor clothing as well as good footwear. All are welcome – especially kids with eagle eyes. The tour will be in English and is not suitable for walking impaired.
